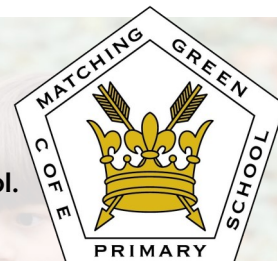


# News from the Green

## Update from Mr Lorkins

Welcome back to the last half term of the school year. The weather has been a bit up and down this week but it has been a real pleasure to see all the pupils settled back into their classes and working hard.

In Potter Class, they have read the story of 'The Tiger Who Came to Tea'. They learnt about animals in the rainforest and have been revising about odd and even numbers and number bonds to 5. In Nightingale Class, they looked at the Lord's Prayer. They also learnt about nutrition through balanced diet and have learnt about time in maths. Darwin Class have continued to learn about the Egyptians and in art they made their own papyrus and turned this into their own Egyptian scrolls. In English, they wrote their own non-chronological reports and in maths they have been continuing to learn about fractions. Shakespeare Class have been writing Shang Dynasty adventure stories. They have been exploring senses in poetry. We are also excited for Shakespeare to start practising for their end of year performance of 'Mamma Mia'.

In worship this week we have been exploring the Christian doctrine of the Trinity as the Church celebrated Trinity Sunday last weekend. We spoke about how Christians believe in the three parts of God, the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. On Thursday we spoke about the disciple Matthew. We spoke about how he had a job as a tax collector which made him hated in Judea at the time. We spoke about for Christians someone's past doesn't matter to Jesus and that in our lives we can also ask for forgiveness when we make mistakes.

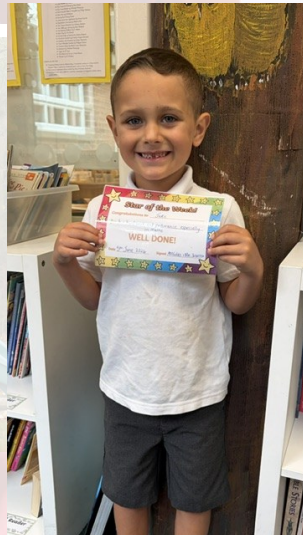

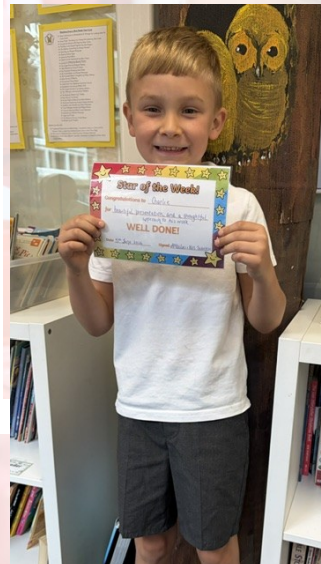
